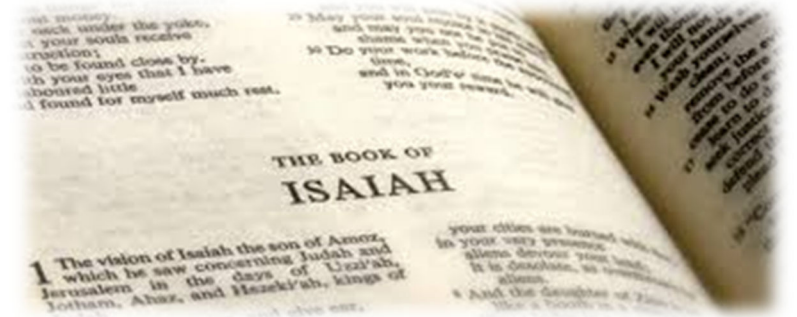

Thought for the Week

When all the sheep who are scattered across the world hear the voice of the Shepherd and are brought to Christ, there will be "one flock" (John 10:16). That is the corporate emphasis of the imagery. But the emphasis falls heavily on the stunning power and authority of the Shepherd – beyond all ordinary power. The sheep already belong to him (v.14), wherever they are in the world, *before* they ever come to him. "I know my own." "I have other sheep." His voice is irresistible when he calls his own (v.16). "They *will* listen to my voice." That is what he means when he says, "I *must* bring them." The voice of Christ will do the bringing.

Confession of our Sin & Assurance of Pardon

Leader: As an act of worship, let us draw near to God and confess our sins together so that we may be forgiven, healed, and empowered to live lives of holiness.

Congregation: Dear Heavenly Father, we confess that we have too often forgotten that we are yours. Sometimes we act as if there were no God at all to help us and we fall short of being a credible witness to You. For these things we ask your forgiveness and we also ask for your strength. Give us understanding of Your Word and faith in Your presence. Remind us to be who You would have us to be regardless of what we are doing or who we are with. Amen.
