Thought for the Week

Abram was learning the basic lesson that every believer has to learn, namely that God's delays are not denials. Though the years were passing and many of his contemporaries were already dead, Abram had continued to rely on the Word the Lord had given him concerning a son. But the time of waiting was agonizingly long, and the Lord, who had taken note of his servant's need for renewed assurance, said, *'Look toward heaven, and number the stars, if you are able to number them'*, which, of course, he couldn't do...This incident highlights for us one of the main truths of the gospel, for faith is central to its message. Abram had received a specific promise from God, but he did not seem to receive what was promised and he could do nothing to achieve it. He was helpless. Yet his response was to look to the greatness of the One who had spoken and to accept that *God* took responsibility for the fulfillment of his promise. Faith rests on the fact that God is faithful.
