Temple Building Campaign of 538-516BC

The 2 Prophets: Haggai & Zechariah Haggai encouraged the returned Jewish exiles to rebuild the temple; Zechariah encouraged them to repent from their sins and renew their relationship with God so they would be ready to worship in the new temple. It took them 22 years to rebuild it.

The 2 public figures mentioned:
Joshua the High Priest
Zerubbabel the Governor (king) of Jerusalem

All four were commanded by God to rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem that was destroyed during the exile.

Thought for the Week

Jesus is not going to leave you half way across the bog. That is not His manner of guiding us. He began; He will finish.
